## **About Penpont**

Situated in the heart of the Brecon Beacons National Park, Penpont is a country estate of 2000 acres, located on the River Usk near Brecon. At the core of the estate is a Grade I listed house, and a historic collection of outbuildings with walled gardens and grounds extending to approximately 40 acres. The house and estate still remain within the ownership of the original family.

In 1992, Gavin & Davina Hogg, a trained arborist and landscape designer, moved to Penpont. As well as managing an extensive restoration program of the buildings and gardens, they have also

established a number of on-site business enterprises including: a holiday cottage, a livestock enterprise, a campsite, a wedding & events venue, a biomass heating system and the organic fruit, flower and vegetable unit supplying the on-site farm shop.

Gavin and Davina's sons Forrest and Josh are also based at the estate working alongside a Forestry Apprentice and two part time staff. Penpont is partnering with Action for Conservation, a youth engagement charity, who run an education programme on the estate inspiring the next generation of conservationists and land workers.

#### About the Walled Gardens

The walled gardens and orchard extend to 1.52 ha, and have been certified with the Soil Association since 2002. A wide variety of vegetable, fruit and flower crops are grown and the farm shop is open from June to Christmas. From January to June, we supply our regular customers with a veg & fruit box, using produce from a local organic wholesaler as well as some of our own.

The gardens have 3 polytunnels, a large lean-to glasshouse, as well as tool & storage sheds. The soil type is a fluvial loam over red sandstone. For the last 20 years a system of green manures has been used to maintain soil fertility, enhanced by creating our own compost and by operating organic principles.

#### In this role you will:

- Be responsible for maintaining the walled gardens and organic vegetable & cut flower production at Penpont
- Manage the operation and maintenance of glasshouse and the other protected cropping systems
- Undertake ground care maintenance: including care of grass & gravel paths, fruit trees, and shrubs, perennial and annual herbaceous plants
- Ensure that the farmshop is well stocked
- Organise veg & fruit boxes for collection, liaise with customers and manage the payments
- Propagation of perennial plants for sale
- Manage occasional volunteers during the busy season
- Help improve aspects of Penpont gardens and grounds as time allows
- Support with other tasks as required, including occasional education days with young people
- Explore and trial innovations in the growing area to improve soil health, productivity and biodiversity
- Be able to help out with watering and irrigation needs on occasional weekends.
