


Putting Sustainability at the forefront

To achieve sustainable production, the Welsh horticulture industry must continue to implement innovative solutions to help combat the current environmental emergency. Here is how Tyfu Cymru is aligning with both the FAO's Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) and the Well Being of Future Generations (Wales) Act.

5 Key Focus Areas to Achieve the SDGs


The FAO has identified five areas which are key to achieving the SDGs:

1. Increase productivity, employment and value addition in food systems
2. Protect and enhance natural resources
3. Improve livelihoods and foster inclusive economic growth
4. Enhance the resilience of people, communities and ecosystems
5. Adapt governance to the new challenges (FAO, 2018)



Our 12 Key Themes

The key areas identified by the FAO and Welsh Government are the foundation for the success of the Tyfu Cymru project and are actioned through our 12 key themes.



Industry actions

The horticultural industry has a significant role to play to tackle climate change, many growers are already leading the way on sustainability through peat free production, reducing their use of main water, carbon auditing and sequestration, reducing single-use plastics, improving soil health, and reducing the use of agrochemicals; which encourages biodiversity and enhances natural habitats.

Our commitments

Soil health

Healthy soils support sequestration and storage of carbon. We have delivered webinars sessions on soil health, crop rotations, composting and peat free horticulture.

Agronomy advice

Expert agronomy advice provided to drive up yield, quality, harvesting, storage and pesticide reduction.

Upskilling

Training leading to more effective and efficient growing and business management, including topics such as carbon auditing, waste reduction, local supply chains and efficient water use.

Pest and disease

Our Integrated Pest and Disease Management (IPDM) programme focuses on preventative and curative actions, reducing the industries use and reliance on pesticides. IPDM has many environmental benefits, notably boosting biodiversity.

Digital delivery

Digital delivery of Knowledge Transfer through online knowledge hub, webinars and virtual study tours, reducing need for travel.

Peat free

Peatlands are the world's largest terrestrial carbon sink. As well as featuring within webinars, peat free is an important discussion topic in our Stakeholders Groups and within our Horticulture Leaders Forum.




Rhoi Cynaliadwyedd ar flaen y gad

5 Maes Ffocws Allweddol i Gyflawni'r Nodau Datblygu Cynaliadwy


Mae'r FAO wedi nodi pum maes sy'n allweddol i gyflawni'r Nodau Datblygu Cynaliadwy:

1. Cynyddu cynhyrchiad, cyflogaeth ac ychwanegu gwerth mewn systemau bwyd
2. Diogelu a gwella adnoddau dynol
3. Gwella bywoliaeth a meithrin twf economaidd cynhwysol
4. Gwella gwydnwch pobl, cymunedau ac ecosystemau
5. Addasu llywodraethu i'r heriau newydd (FOA, 2018)



Hyfforddiant a Chefnogaeth

Wrth ystyried cynaliadwyedd o safbwyt amgylcheddol, economaidd a chymdeithasol, gellid ystyried bod **100%** o'n hyfforddiant yn cael effaith gadarnhaol ar y meysydd hyn. Yn ystod 2021, roedd gan **41%** o gyfanswm ein horiau hyfforddi ffocws cryf ar gynaliadwyedd amgylcheddol.



Gweithredoedd y diwydiant

Mae gan y diwydiant garddwriaeth ran bwysig i'w chwarae wrth fynd i'r afael â newid hinsawdd. Mae llawer o dyfwyr eisoes yn arwain y ffordd ar gynaliadwyedd drwy gynhyrchu heb fawn, lleihau eu defnydd o ddŵr y prif gyflenwad, archwilio a dal a storio carbon, lleihau'r defnydd o blastigau untrio, gwella iechyd y pridd, a lleihau'r defnydd o agrocemegau; sy'n annog bioamrywiaeth ac yn gwella cynefinoedd naturiol.

Cyngor Agronomeg

Cyngor agronomeg arbenigol a ddarperir i gynyddu cynyrrch, ansawdd, cynaeafu, storio a lleihau plaladdwyr.

Llwchsgilia

Hyfforddiant sy'n arwain at dyfu a rheoli busnes yn fwy effeithiol ac effeithlon, gan gynnwys pynciau fel archwilio carbon, lleihau gwastraff, cadwyni cyflenwi lleol a defnyddio dŵr yn effeithlon.

Plâu a chlefydau

Mae ein rhaglen Rheoli Plâu a Chlefydau Integredig (RhPChL) yn canolbwyntio ar gamau ataliol a churadol, gan leihau'r defnydd o blaladdwyr gan ddiwydiannau a'r ddibyniaeth arnynt nhw. Mae gan RhPChL lawer o fanteision amgylcheddol, gan gynnwys rhoi hwbs i fioamrywiaeth.


Cyflwyno digidol


Di-fawn




